WHAT kind of novelist are you? What sort of book do you dream of writing? Have you found your subject matter? If you have not written before, how do you begin?

“So You Want to Write a Novel” is a series of workshops aimed at those who dream of a writing a book, but want some help along the way. This 3-day intensive will consist of lectures, homework, timed exercises and readings that give you the confidence to get your new book down on paper. Sessions will include:

- techniques to start writing or develop a novel already in progress
- six sessions on “Getting Started”, “Characterisation”, “Point of View”, “Setting”, “Plotting & Shaping” & “Editing”
- advice on how to expand your material
- a chance to create new work that feeds into your manuscript
- the opportunity to have your writing read and discussed



The workshop will be conducted in a friendly, constructive atmosphere. It is open to anyone with a desire to write, from beginners to published novelists.

FEES

The fee for the 3-day course is £150. It is preferable to attend the whole course. If that is not possible, you can book as a drop-in participant for £55 a day or £27 a half day. Please note that priority will be given to those who book for the whole course. Drop-in fees must be paid for one month in advance.

PRIVATE TUTORIALS

If you'd like 1-to-1 tuition to discuss your manuscript, appointments can be arranged for a fee of £23 per half hour/£46 per hour.

PAYMENT
