- discover how restructuring transforms a manuscript
- develop an eye for the superfluous, the repetitive, the boring
- learn correct formatting and presentation
- edit your own and others' manuscripts
- have your writing edited and discussed



Workshops will be conducted in a friendly, constructive atmosphere. They are open to anyone who wants to write clearly & effectively.

FEES
